**Note**

IBF super flyweight champion Fernando Martinez became a unified titlist after traveling to Tokyo and capturing Ioka's WBA belt by a well-earned unanimous decision. Martinez was the effective aggressor from start to finish, and his fast start in the first four rounds (136-75 overall, 114-63 power) set the tone and forced Ioka to play catch-up. The 35-year-old veteran did his best, but he simply couldn't keep up with Martinez's buzz-saw attack that saw him average 91.6 punches per round to Ioka's 76.8 and rack up connect leads of 369-279 overall, 61-49 jabs, 308-230 power. Martinez prevailed 11-1 in the CompuBox round-by-round breakdown of total connects, although the two men were separated by three or fewer total connects in rounds six, 10 and 12 and by four in round seven. Ioka was more accurate in power shots (41%-38%) and his body attack was supreme (174-57 in connects), but Martinez was more precise overall (34%-30%) and in jabs (20%-14%) while also being the unquestioned ring general who landed the easier-to-see blows. While Edward Hernandez submitted an absurd 120-108 score, Stanley Christodoudou (117-111) and Jean Pierre Van Imschoot (116-112) were closer to the mark.
