Inside The Numbers

Opetaiia explosively retained his IBF cruiserweight title for the second time in his second reign with a destructive TKO against Australia-based New Zealander Nyika (10-0), who replaced mandatory challenger Huseyin Cinkara on three weeks' notice after the Turkish-based German injured his ankle. The athletic Nyika acquitted himself well, but Opetaiia's two-fisted power proved too much as a right uppercut scored the first knockdown of round four while a flurry highlighted by a right hook and left cross finished the fight moments later and left Nyika face-down and semi-conscious. Nyika regained his feet and left the ring several minutes later after receiving medical attention. The output was similar (Opetaiia averaged 55.3 punches per round compared to Nyika's 50.5) but Opetaiia's accuracy gaps of 36%-23% overall and 38%-30% power) resulted in final margins of 74-44 overall, 29-27 body and 73-39 power (Nyika prevailed 5-1 in landed jabs and 8%-7% in jab precision).
