Inside The Numbers

The fight was stopped after the beginning of the eighth round due to a cut Navarrete suffered over his left eye in the sixth round. That the cut was bleeding into Navarrete's eye and the fight needed to be stopped was not controversial. What caused the cut was the issue. The referee ruled the cut resulted from an accidental clash of heads. Replays showed that after Suarez landed a right hand on the spot of the cut, their heads came together- more of a rub than a clash. Navarrete seemed to start bleeding after he rubbed the spot where Suarez punched him. Because the replay was inconclusive, the California Commission went with the referee's call. After the decision was announced, ESPN's zoomed in slow motion replay showed that Suarez's punch caused the cut.

Prior to the stoppage, Suarez had his best rounds in terms of power punches landed in rounds six and seven, where he landed 30 power punches to Navarrete's 20. Prior to the sixth, Navarrete landed 62 power punches to Suarez's 45. Navarrete out-landed Suarez in 4 of the first 5 rounds, but Suarez was very much in the fight, throwing 300 punches to Navarrete's 269. The cut changed the course of the fight. Instead of being awarded a technical knockout, Suarez was on the losing end of a technical decision. One judge scored the rounds 78-75, while the other two judges scored the fight 77-76, all for Navarrete.
