Inside The Numbers

For four rounds, Jake Paul successfully executed his strategy of fleeing around the ring to minimize Anthony Joshua's opportunities to land punches. During that stretch, Joshua landed 17 punches, and Paul landed 11. Alas, Paul ran, but he could not hide from Joshua, who found his offensive footing in the fifth round to the tune of 14 power punches landed resulting in two knock downs. Joshua closed the show in the sixth round, landing 8 of 13 (62%) of his power shots, and sending Paul to the canvas twice. Paul didn't beat the count after the second knockdown.
