Inside The Numbers

Quintana threw 32 more punches than Tsutsumi, but Tsutsumi landed 33 more punches. Both combatants targeted the body, as 48% of their power punch connects were body shots. Quintana bloodied Tsutsumi's nose with an inadvertent headbut in round one, but Tsutsumi's superior connect rate (56% total punches, 62% power punches) eventually broke Quintana down. At the beginning of the fourth round, Tsutsumi landed a series of power punches to Quintana's head that sent him to the canvas. Quintana got up, but was on shaky legs, forcing the referee to halt the bout at 1:14 of the fourth round.
