Inside The Numbers

Spencer moved up in weight to challenge Robinson for the IBF and WBO middleweight titles, but couldn't offset Robinson's superior accuracy and power. Robinson shook her at the end of the first, fourth, and tenth rounds and connected on 35% of her power punches — a punishing rate at any weight. The judges had little difficulty with their cards, scoring it 99-91 and 100-90 twice, all for Robinson.
